	Call it if I'm <u>blocked and no advantage</u> . I want first call <u>in the area</u> .
Goal	Eye contact, run towards halfway line. Ball remains in play: raise flag, then normal

	Recording: trailing AR, then me, then lead AR. If I'm writing, you watch
Penalty Kick	Intersection of Penalty Area and Goal Line, watch for goal, I'll watch encroachment
Corner Kick	Signal at the flag. Start on the line to watch for goal, then to the second-last defender
Goal Kick	Ensure ball on the 6, then use judgment to top of area/second-to-last
Throw-in	Watch the <u>feet</u> , <u>coordinate</u> calls, signal for <u>in-bounds</u>
Free Kick	Stay with second-last defender, unless I motion for you to be on the goal line
Start/2 nd Half	Count players, check keeper, unfurl flag, subtle thumbs up
Conference	If we need to talk, <u>flag at waist</u> .
Time	Back me up. If I need a time check, hand over patch
Coaches	Ouick subs Technical Area
